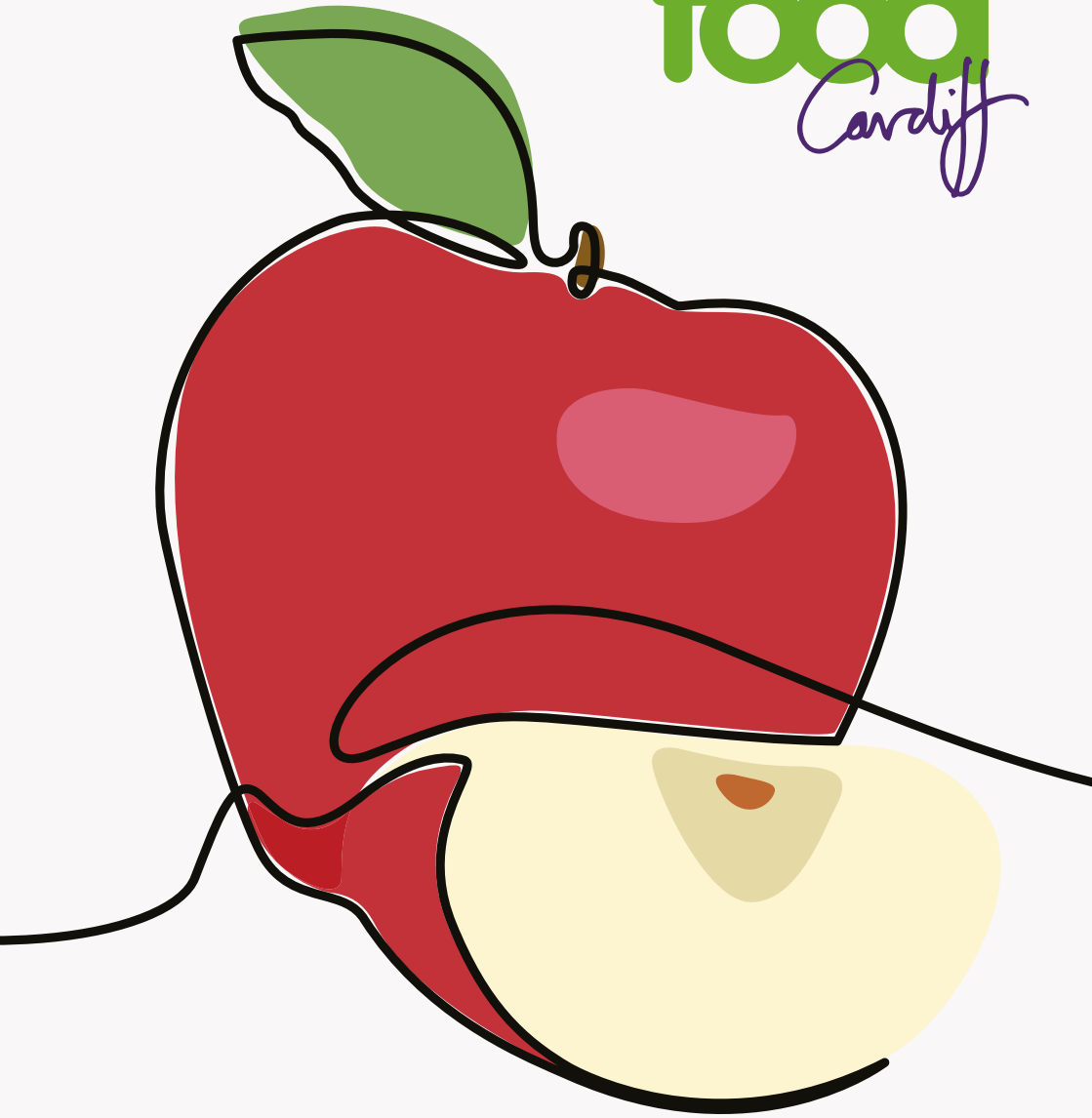

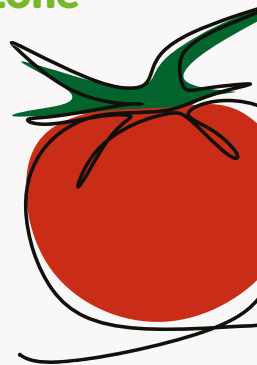

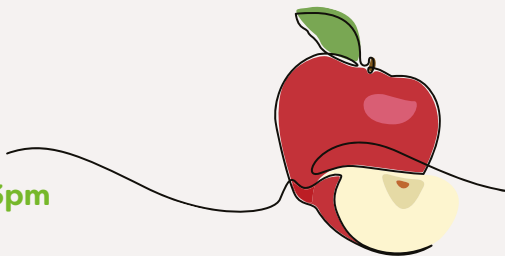


Apple Day

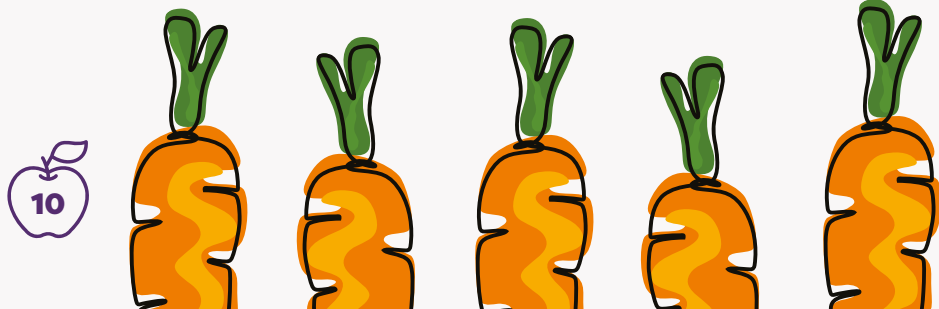
